Background

Renault and Nissan has announced the change in stock share between two companies, in March 2023.

With this announcement and change, both companies will be treated as economically independent entity.

After this change, Alliance Purchasing has been dismissed and ANPQP will take each companies direction.

In order to clearly distinguish the changes. ANPQP Ver.3.2 will restart as NPQP Ver.1.0 in Nissan.

ANPQP ver3.2 migrate to NPQP ver1.0

The NPQP (Nissan Product Quality Procedure) Ver.1.0 released this time has almost the same content as ANPQP ver3.2.

Main revision points

- Name change: Alliance name changed to Nissan name.
- Logo change: From alliance logo to Nissan logo.
- Requirement changes: Delete Renault requirements, leave only the originally listed Nissan requirements.

Start of application

- NPQP ver1.0 will be <u>applied to all models</u> that are already in mass production or under development from November 2023. However, as a transition period, it is **possible to use ANPQP forms until March 31, 2024**.
